## ATHLETIC DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

Mr Moore discussed success of winter programs. He noted wrestling regionals concessions was successful. A new boys tennis coach was introduced at the spring athletic meeting. Form and Fitness in the weight/workout room continues to be a success. Along with the funding from GABC, he was able to attain remaining funds for this year. He is still looking for district funding next year.

## COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Spending & Funding – Jay -- Submitted:

- \$4,000 was approved for funding of the of the instruction by Form and Fitness for the weight room. **No additional payments for future have been requested.** Kevin Moore said the school district and other entities would help fund this request.
- The baseball request was for \$2,000 total for instruction of coaches for winter training at the Bigler facility.
- The \$600 for the HUDL request was 50% of what Kevin Moore submitted. The school district and other entities are to pay the remaining \$600.



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- Basketball warmups \$1,588 (travel tops) for the boys basketball program (Coach James) approved in January.

Membership – Chris- Popcorn was distributed at Freshman night. A few membership forms were handed out. Chris also discussed that other schools require all athlete families be Booster Club members. Mr Moore and Chris looking into how this is applied at these schools.

Newsletter – No new update

Publicity - John asked that people let him know if they have something they want shared.

Concessions – Gretchen: Thank you to Rob and Sue Davis for helping set up the wrestling meet concessions. Also 'thank you' to the Wagners for staying hours longer than their shift when we were short handed at wrestling concessions. Also thank you to my daughter, Allison Viesselmann for her volunteer time. See the financial report for the profit for wrestling meets.

Thank you to Chris and Michele Tsui and Scott and Kristin Garncarz for being the boys and girls basketball concession organizers. Jennifer Bault opened the first and second girls games as well.

Moving on to spring sports:

We are looking for someone to help with track concessions and boys soccer concessions.

Gretchen as if anyone heard anything about concessions for baseball? Discussion was held on this possibility. Concern over getting items from GHS to stand, everything in stand is owned by Little League. Gretchen to continue to look into this.

Other:

There is construction of a new "Hawks Nest" in the works. We would appreciate involvement in the planning of this area as concessions uses this space for storage of items such as the tent, food and equipment. We need efficient access to this area for re-stocking and drop off from Badger Popcorn.

Gretchen needs to purchase two new pizza ovens. One in football broke last fall and we need a second one for the Hawks nest at times.

Also we may need a new microwave for football. Also considering purchasing a small shop vac for cleaning the football and soccer concession stands.

New concession stand has been working ok for the most part. If we have a big event (such as wrestling meet) it is not very efficient and we have a table set up in front of concession stand to wait on customers and we just make food in the concession stand.



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## Liaisons:

Scholarships – Nicole noted that scholarship submissions were closing today. The background of the Kittleson scholarship was discussed. There was discussion on the requirement for being a GABC member to be eligible for this scholarship. Current requirement is only for 1 year. Discussion is should it be for more years. This will be reviewed for future years eligibility.

Corn Roast – The date was confirmed for Aug 25th. Cari confirmed a number of vendors she was able to get for free. Tickets were being ordered on March 5th, we confirmed the same pricing as last year. We will sell tickets at Football game prior to event. We discussed making sure to get advertising in papers. In past, we have worked with the local papers to have them run an article about the event, this results in free advertising.

Discussion was held regarding having Corn Hole again. It was breakeven in the past, but it gave people a reason to stick around and spend money. Scott will do a comparison of event profit over the years to see impact of having additional events going on at the park.

Discussion was also held regarding having teams provide activities at the Corn Roast to earn extra funds. Concern was how to split the profits of these events. It was determined that we need to document a process of how teams would sign up for activities and how profits would be handled. We would look at doing this on a 1 year approval.

Volunteerism – Concession sign-up is now being emailed to all families with athletes.

Raffle - Winter raffle was successful. Starting to look at spring raffle.
