Gretchen donated 50 lb popcorn bag to Special Ed with oil. We are now going to individual bags with oil for ease of use.

Soccer concessions does not have anyone signed up for opening and closing. Can no longer drive items from football concessions to the soccer concessions. Kevin Moore is going to use the school Gator to move them items for Gretchen this week. Discussion on if we push to get the soccer concessions open. The stand is not in good shape. Karen Ruona has offered to help get it cleaned/set up this week. If it rains this week and game is not held at GHS field, then will consider not having soccer concessions this year. Football concessions have been going well. One big game sales similar to Homecoming, other 2 closer to normal.
